Call for Special Sessions

ISWCS'18 welcomes proposals for Special Sessions. Each Special Session will be allocated 100 minutes: 5 lectures (15 minutes' presentation plus 5 minutes' discussion each). The topics of the Special Sessions should be important, new and emerging areas of interest to the communications community and have little overlap with regular sessions.

Each Special Session proposal should include the following:

- A topical title for the Special Session;
- Specification of whether this is an oral or poster session;
- A description of why and how the session will be organized (200 words);
- The titles, authors (plus affiliations), and abstracts (100 words each) of at least 5 invited papers, indicating the invited overview lecture if applicable;
- Brief biographies of the session organizer(s) and their contact information.

Proposals will be evaluated based on the timeliness of the topic as well as on the qualifications of the organizers and the authors of the contributed papers.

The papers in each accepted Special Session will undergo a review process identical to that of regular papers. The organizer of the Special Session will select the reviewers and manage the review process, and in consultation with the program committee, will make accept/reject decisions. It is the responsibility of the organizers to ensure that their Special Session papers meet ISWCS quality standards.

The invited speakers as well as the organizer will be required to register for the conference at the appropriate early-bird or full rates.
